NOTES:

1. Students desiring for further academic studies may substitute two optional courses with a thesis provided that they have an overall Grade of B+ and have completed at least 24 courses in order to qualify.
2. All MDiv students must complete six months of internship (either one of the Mentoring Ministries). This internship is normally completed during the last year of study.
3. A minimum of 50% and a minimum of 30 courses are required to graduation and the student is expected to complete the MDiv within a maximum of 6 years from beginning the programme.
